Minutes of meeting:

- 1) Dr. Diwan congratulated the team for successful organization of IPI-IVC Joint Seminar at Delhi on 23rd July, 2025.
 - a. Dr. Diwan opened the discussion with the overall feedback and opinions of members on IPI-IVC seminar at Delhi. Members shared their views on the joint seminars with IPI mentioning that through seminar at Delhi was attended by more than 200 delegates paid delegates were about 150. The programme went well but repetition of topics was

observed. It was agreed by the members that IVC should prefer to organize seminars joint seminars on select basis.
